- Students are admitted only to Nursery for the new session. Admission to classes other than Nursery is done only if vacancies are created, in such cases preference is given to transfer cases (outstation only).
- 2. For admission to Nursery, the child must have completed 4 years on March 31st, of the applying academic year.
- 3. Children below the age of four will not be admitted and the school sets a maximum age limit for each class.
- 4. A certificate of age from the municipal birth register must be attached to the application for admission. (No change will be made later on). Certificate issued by hospital will not be accepted.
- 5. The application from should be submitted on the specified date and time.
- 6. The original date of birth certificate must be shown at the time of submitting the form.
- 7. Original documents will be checked along with identification of parents with child at the time of interaction.
- 8. Parents who fail to deposit the form or do not present themselves along with their ward on the specified date and time marked on the form will not be entertained.
- 9. Due to limited number of seats available and heavy rush for admission, the management regrets that all applicants registering for admission cannot be accommodated.
- 10. If elder brothers and sisters are studying in the school, parents must not take for granted the admission of younger siblings. It is advisable, therefore, to apply in other schools as well.
- 11. This being an English medium institution the applicants should be able to adjust to the desired standards.
- 12. Parents must give an undertaking in writing that they will abide by the rules and regulations of the school as made from time to time.
- 13. The school does not provide any transport for the students.

If you agree to all the conditions given above, you may fill the application form for admission.
